- ✓ Take the college placement test. (Accommodations can be requested for this test. Call the counselor at the College or ask your school counselor to call us).
- ✓ Request an official high school transcript to be mailed to SVCC. (See your school counselor to make this request.)
- ✓ Submit disability documentation to Disability Services Office (Not required for admission, but is necessary for accommodations).

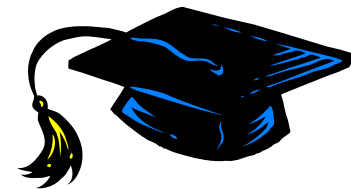

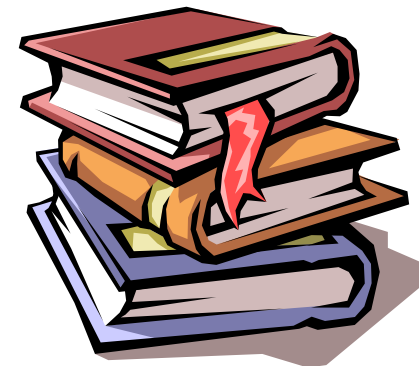
