

## Costs and Financial Aid -November 2023 Update

College tuition and fees for the 67 required credits: \$161.61/credit hour: \$161.61 X 67 = \$10,827.87. Final Tuition rate for 2023-2024 Academic Year will be updated at [Tuition and Fees](#). Other costs include:
