

## Costs of the Practical Nursing Program and Financial Aid

In addition to regular college tuition and fees for the 49 required credits ([Tuition/Fees](#) are \$166.90/credit hour\*:  $\$166.90 \times 49 = \$8178.10$ ), the program requires:

- Pre-clinical book cost estimate: \$600
- Pre-entrance test (TEAS): \$80
- Uniform, lab coat and shoes: \$250 - \$300  
(can vary with type/number of uniforms purchased)
- Books and supplies: \$1000
- Nursing Assessments: \$400-\$450 per semester (\$1200-\$1350 total)
- Graduation Pin: \$50
- Medical Exam/Immunizations: Varies
- Criminal background/drug screen: \$181.75
- CPR Certification: \$75
- Campus Lab and Clinical Supplies: \$250
- Fees for NCLEX-PN & PN license: ~\$400
- Total in addition to Tuition/Fees:..... ~\$4505  
(using \$250 as sample Medical Exam fee)

The above costs are approximate and are subject to change. The student should also consider the cost of transportation to class and clinical sites.
