1. Graduate Success on the NCLEX Licensure Exam

Expected Level of Achievement:

Program's annual licensure examination pass rate will be 80% for all first time test takers during the same 12-month period.

The three-year mean for the licensure examination pass rate will be at or above the national standard.

The national standards are as follows for students passing NCLEX on the first attempt:

2. Program Completion
