Apply to SVCC: www.southside.edu – click “Admissions” If a returning student to Southside, or already a student at another VCCS school, you will need to enter your 7-digit student ID number during the application process. Submit official high school or GED transcript and official non-VCCS college transcripts if any. If prior schools sends electronically, transcript should go to admissions@southside.edu . Mailed transcripts should go to Admissions at either our Alberta or Keysville Campus. Addresses here: https://southside.edu/locations		
Meet with SVCC Counselor to review transcripts, determine if placement test is needed, complete program placement and enroll in classes.		
Complete required Developmental Courses if needed, which is determined by counselor after reviewing transcripts and/or placement test scores. DEVELOPMENTAL COURSES MUST BE FINISHED IN ORDER TO APPLY TO THE PN PROGRAM!		
Attend a Mandatory Nursing Information Session, specific to the year for which you are applying. (Covers both the PN and ADN program – one session meets requirement for either program.) Session is virtual and requires being able to log in to MySVCC to access handouts and further resources. Take ATI-TEAS, Edition 6, earning acceptable scores. Must complete TEAS prior to submitting application and prior to application deadline. More TEAS information here: https://southside.edu/teas		
Submit PN Program application during appropriate application window (See dates on current Nursing Programs Flow Chart). Application is under “Important Links” here: https://southside.edu/certificate-practical-nursing-lpn		
While waiting for start of clinical program, complete as many of the required general education courses as possible, maintaining a GPA of at least 2.0
